

Calendar For Creative Lessons in  
Essential Theology

**August 15**

**Why you shouldn't go to church:**

This lesson is designed to provide students with a foundation for the knowledge and study of God. Students will discover proofs of the existence of God, understand how they can know God, and increase their belief in the possibility of God.

**August 18**

**If actions speak louder...**

This lesson provides a look at the general revelation of God in his creation. Students will investigate the creation story, understand how it provides evidence of God's existence, and be challenged to be observant of how creation speaks to us of its Creator.

**August 25**

**The Almighty...Revealed!**

The purpose of this lesson is to look at how God has chosen to reveal himself through His word. Students will learn how God has revealed himself by word throughout history, begin to understand how God's revelation comes to us today, and commit to daily search the revelation of God through Scripture.

**September 1**

**Describing the Invisible**

The focus of this lesson is to provide students with a basic description of God. Students will learn what God is like, understand how he's a Person and a Spirit, and realize the benefit of God's makeup to every individual.

**September 8**

**Three in One**

The purpose of this lesson is to provide a biblical look at the Trinity. Students will discover each person in the Godhead, understand how they work together in the lives of people, and determine to accept by faith the unity of God.

**September 15**

**Naturally Speaking**

This lesson will provide an overview of the natural attributes of God. Students will learn what some of God's natural attributes are, examine how these attributes affect their personal lives and faith, and begin to recognize these attributes throughout Scripture.

**September 22**  
**It's all about love**

This lesson is designed to provide students with an overview of the moral attributes of God. Students will explore some of the characteristics that make up what God chooses, understand how these attributes can be summarized by God's love, and determine to live in a way that reflects love.

**September 29**  
**What's in a name?**

The focus of this lesson is a closer examination of the names used for God in Scripture. Students will learn some of the names of God, understand what they meant to people in Scripture, and apply the names of God to the personal prayer life.

**October 20**  
**Who's in control?**

The focus of this lesson is on the sovereignty of God. Students will learn to define God's sovereignty, understand their need for God's direction, and determine to live in recognition of God's sovereignty.

**October 27**  
**God's mysterious Will**

This lesson provides a brief look at the will of God. Students will learn ways to determine God's will, understand how to live within God's will, and commit to following God's will with their life decisions.

**November 3**  
**Kingdom Life**

This lesson provides a reflective look at our place in God's kingdom. Students will learn how the kingdom begins, reflect on their place in God's kingdom, and visualize what they want to do with their lives as a result of God's invitation to enter His kingdom.

**November 10**  
**Knowing your Father**

The purpose of this lesson is to take students to the next level of their knowledge of God. Students will examine where they are with God on a personal level, understand what it means for God to be their Father, and begin developing an open relationship with their heavenly Father.
